Established in 2001, the Dutch Fork Choral Society is a non-profit all volunteer community choral ensemble with a passion for sharing the gift of music. Through participation, members have the opportunity to preserve and advance the art of choral singing, in addition to developing their talents by performing a varied and challenging repertoire, both sacred and secular. From Broadway and Negro spirituals to major works by Handel and John Rutter to American Folk and today's popular music, this ensemble strives to bring diversity to its audiences.

Artistic direction is provided by Lawrence Abernathy. Joining the group in June 2014, Lawrence holds a Bachelors of the Arts in Music from the Columbus State University (Columbus, Georgia) and is currenting pursuing a Masters of Choral Conducting at the University of South Carolina. Accompaniment is provided by William Douglas, a classically trained organist and Bachelors of Music candidate in organ performance at USC. And Suzanne Ringer, Director of Music and Organist at St. Peter Lutheran Church in Chapin, SC serves as Assitant Artistic Director and just happens to be Lawrence's mother.

Currently the Society performs two formal programs each year and a mid-winter fundraiser. Rehearsals begin in January for the spring season and in August for the fall/winter season. New members are welcome. Only an informal audition with the director is required. Membership dues are \$60 per year. Artistic Director

Lawrence Abernathy is a Masters Candidate at the University of South Carolina in Choral Conducting and the Director of Music at North East United Methodist Church in Columbia, South Carolina. A native of Irmo, he and attended Dutch Fork High School where he sang with Marjorie Turner and in the choir program at Union United Methodist Church. He holds

the Bachelors of Arts in Music from the Schwob School of Music at Columbus State University where he studied voice with Michelle DeBruyn and choral conducting with Constantina Tsolainou. As a choral conductor he participated in the 2010 ACDA Student Conducting Competition, attended the 2013 University of Georgia Choral Conducting Workshop and the 2014 University of Michigan Choral Conducting Symposium. He has appeared in masterclasses with Jerry Blackstone, Eugene Rogers and Julie Sadskem (University of Michigan), Eric Nelson (Emory University and the Atlanta Master Chorale) Alexander Solovyev (Moscow Tchaikovsky Conservatory of Music), Paul Spicer (Oxford University), Daniel Bara (University of Georgia) and more. As a vocalist, Lawrence sings with The Cecilia Ensemble, a professional early-music ensemble based out of Augusta, GA, Colla Voce out of Columbia, SC and is a founding member of the guitar and voice duo, The Votive Ensemble. Lawrences primary conducting teachers include Larry Wyatt, Alicia Walker, and Constantina Tsolainou.



Assistant Director

Suzanne Ringers 40 plus year musical career began singing solos and playing the piano in her church at the age of 8. Suzanne pursued a Bachelor of Music with emphasis in Church Music, Piano and Voice at Wingate University and obtained a Masters of Church Music with emphasis in Choral Conducting at the Southern Baptist Theological Seminary in Louisville, Kentucky where she studied with John Dickson. Suzanne moved to the Irmo community in 1991 and acted as the Director of Music Ministries at Union United Methodist Church for 21 years. While there she conducted various major works with members of

the South Carolina Philharmonic Orchestra, including the Brahms Requiem, Mozart Requiem, Handels Messiah, Faures Requiem, the Vivaldi Gloria, the Rutter Requiem and Gloria, and various works by Bach, Haydn and others. In 2006, her choirs performed at the Koger Center for the Performing Arts and embarked on a tour of Europe which included stops at St. Stephens Cathedral in Vienna, Austria, Melk Abbey, and Prague. During this tour, they also joined the University of South Carolina Concert Choir to performing the Mozart Requiem, under the direction of Larry Wyatt in honor of the composers 250th birthday. Suzanne has been fortunate to work and study under the batons of conductors such as Ron Bostic, John Dickson, Larry Wyatt, Andre Thomas, Anton Armstrong, William Carroll and many others. Presently, Suzanne is the Director of Music and Organist at St. Peter Lutheran Church in Chapin, SC. She also plays the piano and sings vocals with the SpiritDriven Band at St. Peter. Suzanne works as a Chaplain and Music Specialist with All Seasons Hospice in Irmo.



Accompanist

William Douglas is currently pursuing his Bachelors of Music in Organ Performance at the University of South Carolina and serves as the Music associate and Organist at Shandon United Methodist Church in Columbia, South Carolina. Previously, William has served the congregations of Trinity Presbyterian in Columbia, SC where he acted as the organist and choir director, and was the Music Intern at St. John Anglican Church in Florence, SC. As an organist,

William has been featured as an accompanist at the 2013 Regional American Guild of Organist Convention; was an organ scholar at the 2013 Charlotte Royal School of Church Music where he accompanied the 120 voice choir; was the organist for the 2013 222nd Diocesan Convention for the Episcopal Diocese of South Carolina, and participated in the Organ Institute at Westminster Choir College. William has performed in masterclasses with various organist, including Janette Fishell (Chair Professor of Organ at Indiana University), Walden Moore (Professor of Liturgical Keyboard Skills at Yale), Alan Morrison, Eric Plutz, Matthew Lewis, and Paolo Bordignon.
