Artistic direction is provided by Suzanne Ringer. Suzanne currently serves as the Director of Music and Organist at St. Peter Lutheran Church in Chapin, SC . Accompaniment is provided by Susan Ritchey who currently serves as the Music Director at Mt. Horeb Lutheran Church , also in Chapin, SC.

Currently the Society performs two formal programs each year and a mid-winter fundraiser. Rehearsals begin in January for the spring season and in August for the fall/winter season. New members are welcome. Only an informal audition with the director is required. Membership dues are \$60 per year. 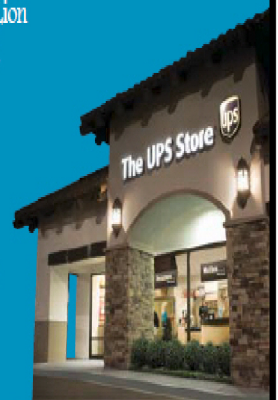
